

SBD Profile - Who works there?

c.26,000 people work in the area

77 IDA Supported companies

60% of people work in 'Information and Communication, Financial' Sector (Census 2016) – compared to 34% across DLR

Multicultural – **25%** of workers come from abroad, including 18% from EU, 7% Rest of the World

42% employed at 'Employers and managers/Higher professionals' socio-economic group

SBD Profile - Who lives there?

c.5,000 people live in the area

Younger age profile of resident – **44%** defined as 'pre-family', i.e. young couples, compared to 13% in DLR and 11% national average

Just 1% retired households, compared to 12% in DLR

Also, for families with children, a very high proportion with preschool children – **55%**, compared with **28%** across DLR

Very multicultural – approx. **50%** of residents come from abroad, including 22% from EU, 27% 'rest of the World'












Development in Sandyford Business District



Over 200,000m² of commercial floor space granted planning permission in Sandyford in the last 5 years – A further 230,000 sq m to be granted – ESB Link Road and Bracken Road Extension are delivered- Planning granted for 540 new homes
