 - to sustainably improve health and wellbeing



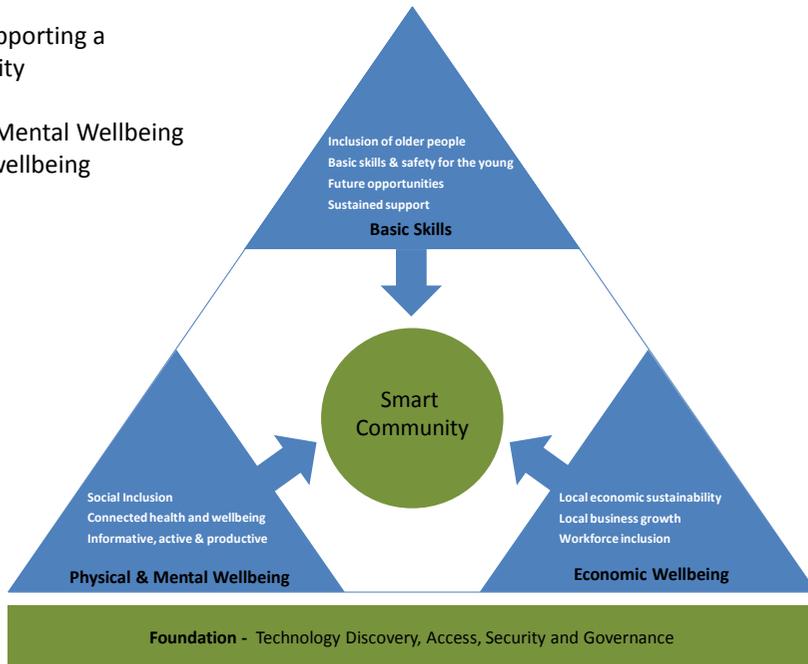

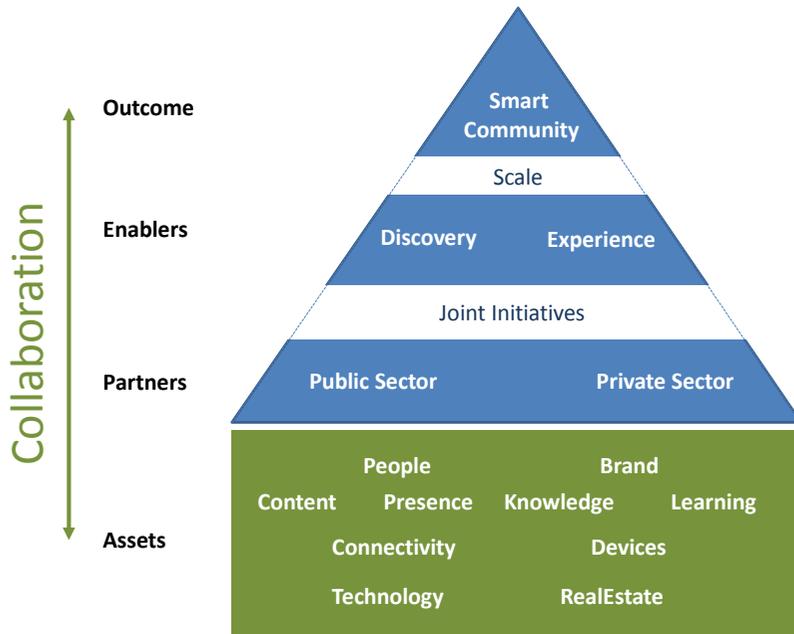




Three Pillars Supporting a Smart Community
